

Wellness: Why Do We Recommend it and What Does it Mean?

Just as your physician would recommend regular testing of your blood, like cholesterol screenings, and routine blood pressure checks for you, the American Animal Hospital Association recommends that annual screening tests should be performed on your pet for baseline levels and early detection of disease. This is important for all ages of pets. Remember, your pet ages more rapidly than you and the risk of developing a chronic or serious disease also increases as they age. Catching these changes before your pet shows symptoms gives us the best chance of detecting and managing illness.
